The Globility Commission organized five own sessions and one joint session in the **34th International Geographical Congress (2021)**.

- c) Environmental risks, resilience, and human mobility (four papers from seven contributors)

- e) Human Mobility in Times of Pandemic is going local? (five papers from 11 contributors)

The joint session with the Geography of Tourism, Leisure, and Global Change Commission:

IGU Ecuador Regional Conference (2023)

In a potential meeting – result of the collaboration between the IGU and the Association of Latin American Geographers – in Ecuador, the Globility Commission would propose some sessions on the issue of Human Mobility from the point of view of the Latin American regional context.

4. Networking, communication, and dissemination

4.a. Networking. As it has already been mentioned, Globility has kept contacts with other IGU Commissions to promote joint sessions in the IGU congresses or regional conferences, as happened with the last IGU Congress with the Commission on ‘Geography of Tourism, Leisure and Global Change’.

4.b. Communication and dissemination. The most important obstacle for the Globility Commission has been to promote the organization of meetings out of the context of IGU events, especially after the pandemic, given the cancellation or postponement of numerous scientific events. Therefore, dissemination activities have been implemented through different channels, above all publications. This is the case of the book entitled ‘International Residential Mobilities - From lifestyle migrations to tourism gentrification’ published in October 2021 in the series on Geographies of Tourism and Global Change, under **Springer Nature Publishers**.

The book studies the relationship between tourism and migration by considering a range of mobilities and a broad geographical spread including but not limited to South Africa, Argentina, Spain, Cape Verde, Hungary, Latvia, Mexico, Portugal, Greece, and Iceland. Its 351 pages offers an interdisciplinary approach, including contributions from geography, sociology, urbanism, economics, tourism and more, which assess the drivers and impacts of new international residential mobilities. It examines the intersection of these mobilities with the increase in the volume of global tourism, the advent of the sharing economy and peer-to-peer platforms, and the effects of transnational property investment. By offering a broad perspective based on different case studies, the book portrays the contradictory consequences of international residential mobilities both favouring local opportunities for development and disrupting housing markets through the disassociation from local demand. As a result, this book is a great resource for academics and students in migration, tourism, and urban studies as well as policymakers and practitioners involved in urban planning, social affairs, and tourism management.

4.c. In compliance with the agreement that Armando Montanari and Josefina Domínguez-Mujica have made with the editor of BELGEO (Christian Vandermotten), a special issue (2022-2) will be

published on the topic “Is human mobility in times of pandemic going local?”

4.d. Another ongoing initiative is the contribution from members of the Globility’s Steering Committee to the book proposed by Jerzy Bański on “Research directions, challenges and achievements of modern geography” under the Springer series on Advances in Geographical and Environmental Sciences. The chapter’s title will be: Global Change and Human Mobility in the Anthropocene.

6. Statement of the mission of the Commission and proposed actions to be undertaken until 2024

6.1. Committee: Complying with the IGU statute's rules, the Steering Committee was renewed in 2020 (four members were replaced, and two former members were appointed as honorary members).

6.2. Objectives:

Founding objective of the Commission:

To examine and interpret those forms of human mobility that may be related to the processes of global change, to new forms of investment, local development, and social and cultural behaviour, all of them within the framework of the following processes:

- The internationalisation of economic activities leads to new forms of short-term labour mobility, and a distinctive feature of such forms of mobility in the way they combine economic, social, and cultural functions and the globalisation of information and knowledge.
- New forms of leisure, recreation, free time, and tourism have provided the bases and strategies for the development and restructuring of urban and rural regions.
- Changes in the knowledge, use and valuation of global resources, and the restructuring of industrial activity transforming the patterns of labour mobility.
- Changes in the organisation and flexibility of labour activities, and in the institutional structure of pensions favour the process of internationalisation of consumption, including retailing and retirement.
- Perspectives on increasing forced (refugee) migrations.

New objective of the Commission, following the founding one previously stated:

To elaborate new thoughts and ideas regarding the unexpected pandemic influence on the nexus between mobility and immobility because of the disruption of the physical mobility at different geographical scales. Consequently, it will be necessary to assess the long-term impacts of this pandemic on human mobility and their uneven effects.
